

REPORT: FERA at European Co-production Forum at BOZAR in  
Brussels – February 7-8



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The **European Co-production Forum (ECPF)** took place at **BOZAR Centre for Fine Arts**, in Brussels and spanned over two days, on 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> of February, 2020. The event gathered key stakeholders and decision-makers from the European audiovisual industry to debate the current state and the future of co-productions in Europe. The different sections of the event focused on current and novel financing mechanisms for co-productions, the situation of streaming platforms in Europe, European storytelling, green filmmaking and the greening of the industry as well as training and schools in production equipped to face the evolution of the industry.

The roundtable was open to all cinema and TV authors, showrunners and literary directors.
